

Daily Routine with lab

- Come in classroom,; put book bags, purses, etc. on floor under desk or in the seat of you desk; and get ready for learning. Students may go to the restroom, get a drink, or go to locker, as long as they are back in time for the bell. If you are not in the classroom by the bell, you are tardy.
- Attendance will be taken. While attendance is being taken, students will be putting on aprons, washing hands, and prepping sinks.
- After ten minutes teacher will go over lab and give lab assignments.
- New material maybe introduced and or instruction given. This can include short lecture and note taking. Students are responsible to participate since most of their grade is participation and daily class grade is giving. This will include work completed during class period.
- Group work is time for families to work on assignments, share ideas, and complete work as a group or individually if necessary. Any unfinished work will be required as homework.
- There will be a review and question period, and sharing time at the end of class. Students will share what they learned, show ideas and give examples.
- End of class: students are required to clean up their desk area, put class material away PROPERLY the way they found it, if not neater. All trash will be thrown away, desks, straightened in proper place, and desks cleaned off.
 - Students are responsible for participating in class discussions using proper etiquette by sharing, taking turns, and respecting others.
 - Sleeping is not allowed, nor is private conversation that disrupts the class. Rude comments or disrespectful attitudes will not be tolerated in the classroom.
