

Daily Routine with lab

- Come inside the classroom, pull out your journal and writing tool; put book bags, purses, etc. on floor and get ready for learning. Students may go to the restroom, get a drink, or go to their locker, as long as they are back before the tardy bell, otherwise you will be marked tardy.
- Attendance will be taken.
- After ten minutes the teacher will go over lesson, review the previous day's activities and answer any questions.
- New material maybe introduced and /or instruction given. This can include short lecture and note taking. Students are required to take notes since most of their grade is participation and a daily class grade is giving.
- Group work is time for students to work on assignments, share ideas, and complete work as a group or individually if necessary. Any unfinished work will be assigned as homework.
- There will be a review and question period, and a sharing time at the end of class. Students will share what they learned, show ideas and give examples.
- End of class: students are required to clean up their desk area, put class materials away PROPERLY (the way they found it, if not neater). All trash will be thrown away, desks cleaned off and, straightened in proper place.
 - Students are responsible for participating in class discussions using proper etiquette by sharing, taking turns, and respecting others.
 - Sleeping is not allowed, nor is private conversation that disrupts the class. Rude comments or disrespectful attitudes will not be tolerated in the classroom.
